Qualification Description

This qualification is an entry-level qualification aimed at individuals entering conservation and land management industry. It allows individuals to develop basic skills and knowledge to prepare for work. They may undertake a range of simple tasks under close supervision. The range of technical skills and knowledge is limited.

No occupational licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

- Entry level environmental staff
- Queensland Industry Trainees and workers
- Partner Program Delivery Trainees (Community Support and Delivery Strategy)



Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in: 6 units of competency (2 core units plus 4 elective units) Electives are to be selected from the elective list or from the elective lists of Certificates I or II of this or any other endorsed Training Package or Accredited Course. Selected units must be relevant to job outcomes in conservation and land management and must be chosen to ensure the integrity of the qualification outcome at AQF level 1.
