Minimum entry requirements

The Qld Weapons Act defines the licensing requirements and use of firearms in Queensland.

- For participation in a firearms safety Training Course a person must not be disqualified or prevented from obtaining a license under the Weapons Act 1990.
- A person may possess and use a weapon without a license under certain circumstances. These are:
- A person who is eligible to obtain a license may have possession and use a weapon at a range approved for the category of weapon, if they have produced photographic identification and signed the appropriate forms. Possession and use must be supervised by a range officer.
- Full license holders must be at least 18 years of age.
- Children of at least 11 years of age can use certain firearms, with adult supervision, under a minor's license.
- A person is ineligible to hold a Weapons Act License if, within the past five years, they have been convicted of offences including misuse of drugs, or weapons, and the use or threatened use of violence.
- A person is ineligible to hold a Weapons Act License if they are or have been the subject of a domestic violence order in the past five years
